Everyone in life goes through times of trouble. We get hurt, broken, disappointed, and tested to the very brink of desolation. We often focus during these things on the outward trials we face when in truth, it's the inward struggles that are far more significant.

After all, what can illness do to us if the soul is strong? We may be sick, but we will not despair. What can financial burdens do to us if we trust in the Lord? He will provide all our needs. What can those who would hurt us or antagonize us accomplish, if our faith is secure? God will defend us. That's the feeling you get when you read Psalm 94. The whole Psalm is dedicated to assuring those who are suffering at the hands of others, that God listens and God will make things right in the end. I'm especially fond of a particular section of the Psalm 94:16-19...

Who will rise up for me against the evildoers? Who will stand up for me against the workers of iniquity? Unless the Lord had been my help, My soul would soon have settled in silence. If I say, "My foot slips," Your mercy, O Lord, will hold me up. In the multitude of my anxieties within me, Your comforts delight my soul.

Who will stand up for me? Who is my help? Whose mercy will hold me up? We get so distraught so many times when we forget just how mighty and powerful God truly is. Just because things are not right in our lives today doesn't mean God is absent. He is always with us and can give us the strength and courage to face whatever hardship we're dealing with. Notice the last verse...In the multitude of my anxieties within me, Your comforts delight my soul.

I love that thought, that God causes delight in spite of all the anxieties we face. That in all the trouble we're dealing with God digs deep inside our hearts and fills us with delight. So, let us ask God to delight our souls when trouble comes at us, and know that God hears us. He will not abandon us, nor is he ever far from those who call upon Him.
