Hospitality, Webster says is the friendly treatment of guests or strangers. Hospitality is also an act of encouragement. Paul admonishes us to encourage each other. Jesus admonishes us to help those who are needy, to entertain strangers.

*"For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you come to visit me." **Matthew 25:35, 36.***

So many times, we have good intentions of doing something for someone needy, or we plan to show hospitality, but it stops there. We are cautioned about this in **James 2:15, 16**. He asks us what good is it if we do nothing about their physical needs. He tells us to care for our brothers and sisters who are in need.

In **1 Peter 4:9,10**, Peter tells us to offer hospitality to one another without grumbling. We are to use whatever gift we have received to serve others. John tells us that if we see a brother in need and show no pity, how can the love of God be in us? (**1 John 3:17**)
