"Speaking Boldly"

[The disciples praying after Peter and John were released from jail:] "Now, Lord, ... enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness. Stretch out your hand to heal and perform signs and wonders through the name of your holy servant Jesus." After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly. — [Acts 4:29-31 NIV](#)

The early followers of Jesus were facing harsh opposition from the very folks who had Jesus crucified. Rather than complaining about or fearing this opposition, the believers confessed the greatness of God and asked for the strength to boldly proclaim the message of Jesus. In response to their prayer, the place where they were meeting was shaken, and they were all empowered by the Spirit to speak the word of God with boldness. Shouldn't this also be our prayer in a culture that is growing more and more hostile to God? Why not pray for the power of the Holy Spirit so you can boldly proclaim Jesus, treating people with gentleness and respect (cf. [1 Peter 3:15](#)).

So many things happen in our lives that we do not understand. We ask God, "Why?" Why did You allow this to happen? What good can come of this? How does He feel about our questioning Him? Does this anger Him?

"For My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways. As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My thoughts than your thoughts." (Isaiah 55:8-9)

How do we react when good things are happening in our lives? Do we just go along, happy as a lark, thinking that this is just a part of life, the way it should be?
