CHOOSING GOD – CHOOSING LIFE

Genesis 3:1-3

As Adam and Eve each looked at the forbidden tree, they faced a life-or-death decision. People want life – but most want it on their own terms. They want to accept God’s way as long as it seems reasonable to them: if its demands are not too high, if they can still do what they want to do and chart their own paths. This is what Adam and Eve had to struggle with because the serpent made God’s way seem unreasonable. According to the tempter, either they had misunderstood God about dying or God was lying because He knew that eating of the forbidden tree would make them like Him.

The serpent implied that having only two ways – life or death – seemed too harsh. Even though Adam had heard the divine instructions about only these two options, he became convinced through Eve that the serpent, not God, was telling the truth. When Adam and Eve took of the fruit and ate it, they inadvertently chose the way of death. This is the same basic choice that has always confronted humankind. It calls each of us to make a decision: Life or death, which will we have?

During Jesus' ministry, He taught that the narrow gate leads to life and the broad gate leads to destruction (death) ([Matthew 7:13, 14](#)). The one "who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son will not see life, but the wrath [verdict of death, or eternal separation] of God abides on him" ([John 3:36](#)). The one who listens to and "believes" in God who sent Christ "has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life" ([John 5:24](#)). Jesus is the way to life ([John 14:6](#)), but those who refuse to believe in Him will die in their sins (be lost). They cannot go where He is going, namely, to heaven ([John 8:21, 24](#)).

As we face the choice between life and death, we are compelled to choose life. Jesus died so that we would not have to die. Let us choose life in Him.
