Our Love for Christ

... whom having not seen you love. Though now you do not see Him, yet believing you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory - **1 Peter 1:8**. Three key words in this verse are: love, faith (believing) and joy. Our love for Christ is “the living water” of His Spirit (**John 4:14**) which He poured out in our hearts (**Romans 5:5**) when we repented and were baptized (**Acts 2:38**).

Our love for Christ is more than a mere “feeling” or “emotional high”. It is a spiritual power which works in Christians to help us love Christ and keep His commandments (**John 14:15**). **For this is the love of God that we keep His commandments. And His commandments are not burdensome - 1 John 5:3**. If we serve the Lord Jesus with the love He has poured into our hearts, our obedience will be an easy yoke and a light burden (**Matthew 11:30**). Those who focus on the Lord’s commandments as “law” will be heavily burdened. Those who focus on Jesus and His love, will be like Jacob who worked for Rachel’s hand in marriage seven years, which seemed only a few days to him because of the love he had for her (**Genesis 29:20**). For those who know Christ and His love, our years of labor for Him pass quickly!

God’s love motivated Christ to give His life for us on Calvary. Our love for Christ should motivate us to deny ourselves and yield ourselves to Him as living sacrifices, as we count ourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God

in Christ Jesus our Lord (**Romans 6:11**). It is a Biblical principle that great love will beget great faith, so that the more we focus our faith upon Jesus, the more He will fill us with His agape (perfect) love! Our wings of faith and love will lift us ever closer to our loving Lord in heaven until one glad morning we will fly away to our eternal heavenly home with Him.

In the meantime, let us take time each day to enter the secret place of prayer to drink a fresh supply of His love, which alone can strengthen us and make us more joyful people. The Father promises to reward those who seek Him in their secret place of prayer (**Matthew 6:6**).
