Reflecting on a Mother’s Love

Some may recall a “Mothers’ Day” sermon I preached a few years back which drew upon God’s “motherly” qualities. There are characteristics of God’s love that speak of a mother’s love. By no means does this imply that God is “a mother” rather than “a Father”, but His perfect love reflects the unique beams of a devoted mother’s love. The inspired assurance is: *“As one whom his mother comforts, so I will comfort you.” (Isa. 66:13)*

Our God is the God of all comfort (2 Cor. 1:3-4). The Holy Spirit is the Christian’s “Comforter” (John 14:26 KJV). Just as a baby’s cries in the night will bring his mother rushing to his side, so our cries will summon God’s comfort when we most need it. There is no greater source of comfort in this world than the arms of a baby’s (or child’s) mother. When he is hurting no one can provide the comfort that mom can!

Sadly enough, it is also true that even a mother’s comfort can be rejected. A child can resist a mother’s comfort. We have all seen the child who sits up stiffly in his mother’s arms when he doesn’t want to be comforted at bed time. What a shame that a mother’s comfort and tenderness can be rejected. It is even a greater shame

when we stubbornly reject God's tender love and comfort. The good news is that there is no hurt that is so great, that it is impossible for us to find God's comfort if we will turn our cries of help toward Him. When the child's cries echo in the stillness of the night, the most welcome sound is the mother's voice as she assures her beloved child: "Here I am."

"Can a woman forget her nursing child, and not have compassion on the son of her womb? Surely they may forget, yet I will not forget you. See I have inscribed you on the palms of My hands" (Isa. 49:15-16). What a reminder from the prophet that though a mother's love may be the greatest love humans know in this life; God's love is even greater than the tenderness, love and comfort of an earthly mother! The proof of God's great love is on the palms of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ!
