God’s Amazing Grace

The Christian life is one of faith in Christ & God’s grace (Eph. 2:8-10). Christians must understand that there are two aspects of God’s grace. First God’s grace provides Christ’s righteousness when we are baptized into Him for the remission of our sins (Acts 2:38), as we clothe ourselves in His perfect righteousness (Gal. 3:27; Rom. 3:22). It is vital that we fully embrace Christ’s righteousness if we are going to know we are saved and possess eternal life (1 Jn. 5:13). Too many years I lived a “hope so” Christianity because I didn’t possess the “know so” confident faith which God’s grace provides. All too many Christians try to “be good enough” to win God’s favor, which produces a false “performance-focused” religion. Christianity is “grace focused”. Salvation from the guilt of sin is God’s gift of grace which no one can earn or merit through mere human effort.

The other aspect of God’s grace is the power of Christ that makes it possible to live the Christian life. Jesus taught that apart from Him we can do nothing (Jn. 15:5). Paul said “I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me” (Phil. 4:13). The Christian life can never be successfully lived by human will power or determined effort. It is a life of faith made possible only by fixing our eyes upon

Christ and fully trusting Him alone to help us live to the Father's glory.

Jerry Bridges compares the two vital aspects of God's grace to spiritual bookends that support the Christian life. Just as loose books must be propped up and supported by bookends to keep them from collapsing or falling off the shelf, our Christian lives must also be reinforced by God's grace to prevent us from collapsing or falling into willful sin.

Everything we do in Christianity is related to God's grace which makes possible our salvation from sin and His spiritual power to live the Christian life. Through Christ, our God makes us His holy workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works (Eph. 2:10). "The arm of flesh will fail you; you dare not trust your own".
