## Reflections on Psa. 138:2

In my daily "Quiet Time", the Lord powerfully impressed on my mind this verse, filled with God's prophetic insight. **Psa. 138:2: I will worship toward Your holy temple and praise Your name for Your lovingkindness and Your truth, for You have magnified Your word above all Your name.**

All OT Jews made it a practice to pray to the Father in the direction of Jerusalem, the location of His holy temple. What an awesome privilege the Lord has given NT Christians to make us His holy temple by placing His Holy Spirit into us! (1 Cor. 6:19) This marvelous privilege answers the question: "Which direction should Christians face when we pray?" Jesus answers our question in His sermon on the mount: **when you pray go into your room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in the secret place (Matt. 6:6).** Christians can fall on their knees anytime, anyplace, facing any direction to offer prayer and worship to God!

Christians have the privilege to **praise His name for His lovingkindness and His truth, for He has magnified His word above all His name.** We need to devote some serious thought to these inspired words of the psalmist! From a NT perspective,

Christians know that God's word and God's truth is the Lord Jesus Christ (Jn. 1:1; 14:6). The psalmist declared that Yahweh has magnified His word (Jesus Himself) above all His name! The Father did this when He raised Jesus to sit at His right hand on the throne of His glory in heaven.

Jesus taught **that all should honor the Son just as they honor the Father (Jn. 5:23)**. No one can go wrong when we obey Jesus' teaching to honor the Son just as we honor the Father as reflected in **John 14:13-14**. Some translations (including NKJV) leave the impression that Jesus just repeated Himself in these two verses: <sup>13</sup> **And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.** <sup>14</sup> **If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.** The ESV more accurately translates: <sup>13</sup> **Whatever you ask in my name, this I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.** <sup>14</sup> **If you ask me anything in my name, I will do it.** NT Christians pray to the Father in the name of Jesus but we should also include Jesus in our prayers of petition and thanksgiving!
