"For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light (for the fruit of the light consists in all goodness, righteousness and truth) and find out what pleases the Lord. Have nothing to do with the fruitless deeds of darkness, but rather expose them."

Ephesians 5:8-11 Light makes us think of things pure and good, while darkness makes us think of the opposite.

Our light should shine before men, that they may see our good deeds and praise the Father in heaven. Matthew 5:16

Just as light produces growth in plants, it will produce a growth in us. If we live in God's light, we will produce the fruits of goodness and righteousness. Living in darkness hinders us from this growth. Light exposes what is in darkness, and will show sin for what it really is. Walk into a dark, unfamiliar room. The unknown can be frightening. Turn on a light. What a difference!

Paul told the Ephesians that they were once in darkness, but were now light in the Lord. How do you find this light? He told them to live as children of light, find out what pleases the Lord. We are not to participate in the sinful life-style of unbelievers. We are to, "have nothing to do with fruitless deeds of darkness." *Ephesians 5:11* Again Paul says, "...in which you shine like stars in the universe.." *Philippians 2:15*

Our light should shine for all to see, not just for others who are in the light also. Our light should be an encouragement for those in the light, a guidance for those who are in darkness.
