*For therein is revealed a righteousness of God from faith unto faith: as it is written, But the righteous shall live by faith--Romans 12:17*

One of my favorite songs is” Living By Faith” written by James Wells and R. E. Winsett. Every verse of the song proclaims a strong faith in God.

The eagle does not escape the storm. The eagle uses the storm to its advantage. Wow! What a great lesson for you and I to learn. Living by faith in Jesus above, trusting and confiding in his great love, let his power lift us above the storms of life and keep us safe in his sheltering arms.
