## *The Spirit God Has Given Us*

*For God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control-2 Timothy 1:7*

Finding ourselves in an unprecedented time of uncertainty, these words of divine inspiration should serve as a source of great encouragement and comfort to us as we walk this earthly pathway faithfully trusting and confiding in our God ([Isaiah 12:2](#); [1 Timothy 4:10](#); [Hebrews 14-16](#)).

Today, America is in the grasp of a virus that has drastically changed our everyday way of life. This virus has created an emotion of apprehension and uneasiness of mind that has caused sound judgment that should lead men and women to think and act with self-control to be forgotten or ignored by many individuals. This virus must be taken seriously because it poses a great danger to all of us. It is serious, people are dying from it. Certainly, we need to be concerned. But, my friends, we must not let fear of this virus become our constant companion. The hired hand replied: "I always see that I do all that needs to be done before I go to bed; and then when the wind blows I know I have nothing to worry about" My friends, when we know what we should do and do it, it is then that the peace of God guards our heart and we have nothing to worry about (**Prov.3:13-26**). Today, I find myself singing "I know the Lord will find a way for me, If I walk in heaven's light, Shun the wrong and do the right, I know the Lord will find a way for me."
