"A Dwelling Place of God"

*And in [Jesus] you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit. **Ephesians 2:22 NIV***

"Where can I go to find God?" Mortals have asked this question ever since they were driven from the garden and from their daily walks with God in "the cool of the day" ([Genesis 3:8-24](#)). Nations have had wars over this question. Families have been split over this question. People have spent countless amounts of money to go on pilgrimages to answer this question. However, in this one passage, Paul reminds us of an inestimable grace: God lives in his people. Jesus had promised that where two or three are gathered together in his name, he would join them ([Matthew 18:20](#)), but we sometimes forget it. God chooses to come and live among people who offer themselves to him as followers of Jesus. That makes each Christian ([1 Corinthians 6:19](#)) and each congregation of Jesus' people ([1 Corinthians 3:16-17](#)) a sacred place where God dwells — no matter how large or small the group is or where it meets.

Have you heard, “It is just too hard to be a Christian?” It is too hard not to! God does not expect perfection. He does want us to try. **“Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect.” Matthew 5:48**

In **1 John 5:3**, he tells us, ...“**And his commands are not burdensome...**” He has not made it too difficult. How much easier our life is, when we obey his commands!

This does not mean that our life on this earth will be a “bed of roses” if we are a Christian. But it does mean that we have a hope, a comfort for whatever might happen. In fact, sometimes it seems that many “bad” things happen to godly people. Why? Why not? They are much more able to cope with it because of God’s promises. (Read **1 Cor. 10:13**)

The devil wants us to think that God’s commands are a burden, a load too heavy for us, especially in the world today. He wants to deceive us as he did Eve. He loves our busy lives that keeps us from our Christian duties.

Jesus tells us, **“Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest...For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.” Matthew 11:28, 30**
