The Gospel and Righteousness

Only God, who knows the hearts of all men, knows how many falsely believe that as long as they are “good, moral people”, they are headed to heaven in the end. “After all, they assure themselves, I’m as good as many of the Christians I know.” And that may well be the case. However, the question is not “how good am I?”, but “am I perfect?” Our perfect God dwells in a perfect place and only those who are perfect (righteous) will be allowed to go to heaven!

No man knows all the people of the world, but God who perfectly knows every heart declares: “There is none righteous, no not one” (**Rom. 3:10**). If this is true, how can anyone go to heaven? The simple gospel answer is “only those who trust Christ as their perfect righteousness.” The only passage that may best sum up the essence of the gospel is **Romans 3:19-26**. In this passage Paul makes it clear that all stand guilty in the sight of our holy God, “for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God” (**v.23**).

That is the bad news for the entire human race. The good news is that through the gospel of Jesus’ death, burial and resurrection (**1 Cor. 15:3-4**) we are “justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus” (**Rom. 3:24**).

The word “justified” is most easily understood as “just as if I’d never sinned.” God’s grace declares freely that though we sin,

by faith in Christ we are accounted "righteous" in His holy sight. Paul says that Jesus was made to be sin for us that we might become the righteousness of God in Him (2 Cor. 5:21).

Praise the Lord for His perfect grace!
