“Have Faith in God”

Mark 11:22

When Jesus commanded His apostles to have faith in God, He was also warning against having "faith in self". Solomon warned that a fool trusts in his own heart, but those who trust in the Lord walk wisely and will be delivered (**Prov. 28:26**). Self-confidence is far less significant than Christ-confidence!

Another point we can draw from Jesus is to have faith in God, not in the world around us. Look around and you will see a drying up of sorts in the economy, job market, and career prospects. It is not wise to place undue trust in your job, career, company, business, who you know, or what you think you have. The Dow crumbles, banks fail, companies downsize, houses burn down, insurance folds, people change, lights go out, crowds get thin, friends get fewer. Any way you look at it, this world is shaky. For many “the American Dream” has only become a nightmare! Only faith in God brings contentment!

A wave sweeping the religious community brings us to the third warning that we should avoid and that is avoid placing faith in those who call themselves “saints”. Such men (and women) prey on the nervousness of people and attempt to sell them anything religious. “Faith in the man” is the product they are selling. The object is the man. Our object must be God and not man! Others are selling "faith in the thing" – these mail-order blessings: believe and receive; send me \$, name it and

claim it; send me \$ and I'll send you holy oil, a prayer cloth or handkerchief to heal your disease(s).

Finally [Mark 11:22](#) tells us that we should only **HAVE FAITH IN GOD** –unreserved and absolute trust in Him alone! Have faith in God – not Buddha, Mohammed, Hinduism, Judaism, Idolatry or any other false religion. Faith is “the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen ([Heb. 11:1](#)). Faith is counting things that are not, as though they were ([Rom. 4:17](#)).

Most of us have lived a few days and we've seen burdens lifted and the sin-sick healed. We've viewed many dark days. However, I know what faith in God should mean for all of us. Faith means seeing the invisible, standing on the unknown, hearing the unheard, having confidence in the unseen, waiting on the unannounced, listening for the unspoken, accepting the inconceivable. A little faith will bring your soul to heaven; a great faith will bring heaven to your soul. Faith does not believe that God can, but that God will. How are we going to triumph in these tough times? Four words: “Have faith in God!”
