SQUARE PEGS AND ROUND HOLES

So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart, praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.

Acts 2:47,48

The Church is alive and active today just as it was more than two thousand years ago. The Church is a Living Organism not an Organization: Webster defines an organization as – association, society <charitable organizations>, b: an administrative and functional structure (as a business or a political party); also, the personnel of such a structure. It defines an organism as – a complex structure of interdependent and subordinate elements whose relations and properties are largely determined by their function in the whole, an individual constituted to carry on the activities of life by mean of organs separate in function but mutually dependent – a living being. We recognize the Church as a living organism in such passages as **Ephesians 1:22, 23** where it is referred to as the body of Christ of which He is head of. Also, this body is made up of many members (**Romans 12:4, 5** and **1 Corinthians 12:13, 14**). So, then each one of us who have been baptized into Christ are now a living and vital function of the body.

Each member has been given a gift or role in the body. The apostle Paul speaks of each member being given or allotted

different gifts or functions (**Romans 12:3-8**). Paul points out that each one has been dealt a measure of faith. God has brought all Christians to faith by the hearing of His word – **Romans 10:17**. Yet, the “measure of faith” spoken of here is the specific office or work delivered to each Christian. Paul then begins to speak of the different gifts – **Romans 12:6-8**. He speaks of prophecy, service, teaching, exhortation, giving, leadership, and mercy. In **Ephesians 4:11, 12**; Paul identifies various roles in the Church and the purpose of those roles, “for the equipping of the saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ.” As one studies the spiritual gifts found in **Romans 12:3-8**, they cannot help but to conclude that they are for this purpose also. They would also be for the purpose of the Church, “to proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light” – **1 Peter 2:9**. Each of us as members of the body of Christ have been given a gift, a spiritual gift from God. The question we must ask ourselves, “am I using my gift” and “am I using my gift to the glory of God and the up-building of the body?”

So many times, we feel like square pegs and round holes, we just don't know where we fit in. We feel that if I am not a member of a certain family or not of a certain group that has been in attendance for a long time, I do not fit in. It is like trying to fit that square peg in a round hole. If we make a brother or sister feel this way, shame on us as a Church! Paul speaking of the body recognizes that each member of the body is important and fits in (**1 Corinthians 12:21**). Each member is an important part of the body, and has a role to fulfill. Now it is up to each of us to find our place and go to work for the glory of the Master and His kingdom.
