Helping Each Other

*Therefore comfort each other and edify one another,
 just as you also are doing.*

1 Thessalonians 5:11

Since God is our Father, we are brothers and sisters; we are God’s family. Helping our family is an important role for us as members of the church.

God has given us directions on helping our spiritual brothers and sisters; “Encourage one another and build up one another...(5:11). Is that our aim? Can we look at our brothers and sisters and think, “I’m working on encouraging this person so that he will be built up”? Can we say to them, face to face and with conviction, “I’m working on encouraging you so that you will be built up”? Can a fellow Christian say about one of us, “There is my brother or sister who is encouraging me so that I will be built up”?

In a kingdom of light surrounded by darkness, God wanted these Christians to be reminded constantly that they were not just part of God’s kingdom, but part of God’s family. In what better way can we be reminded of this than by having a congregation full of brothers and sisters to help us, support us, encourage us, sympathize with us, warn us, and love us?

As Christians, we should have no sense of loneliness, no feelings of being left out, no thoughts that others do not care about us or that we do not fit in. Our fellow Christians have it as their role to give us constant support – not just so that we will survive, but so that we will be built up and strengthened, so that we will grow and mature.

Why does this not always happen in the church? Perhaps we have not been taught about the importance of this help. Perhaps we have been taught but have not taken this message into our hearts. Perhaps we have been embarrassed to seek or to offer help.

Doing what God wants in this matter ought to be the concern of every Christian, every family, every church, every elder, every preacher, every teacher. God wants everyone in His family to help and to be helped by living this way. This help will prepare us for the coming of Christ!

Conclusion. Jesus' return will be the climax of this life and the start of an even better life for the faithful Christian. To share in that return and its new beginning should be the goal of every Christian.

Do we anticipate this event with joy? We should answer not only with our lips or our minds, but also with our lives. We are to live as children of light and help our brothers and sisters as they walk with us in God's light.
