“The Trouble” The Secret of the Cross

Why is it that so many Christians attend church, read their Bibles, and pray regularly, but seem unable to overcome sin and enjoy a life filled with the love, peace and joy of the Lord? The answer may lie in the fact that such believers do not know what it is to die to self and the world of sin. They have repented of certain sins, but do not know what it is to turn, not only from sin, but also from their old nature and self-will.

Jesus told His disciples that if they wished to follow Him, they must deny themselves, take up their crosses daily and follow Him (**Luke 9:23**). Jesus’ command means that we must learn to count our human nature as sinful and under the sentence of death. We must surrender ourselves, our will, all self-effort, and any goodness of our own, and learn instead what it is to live our lives in the fullness of God’s Spirit.

Paul, in more than one of his epistles, makes it clear that we are dead to sin, but alive in Christ, so that we might

receive and experience the power of the new life through the working of the Holy spirit in us every day. Thus, the great work of His Holy Spirit is to reveal Christ in our hearts that we might live as “crucified ones”, as we make way for the Living Crucified One to live His life within us.

God desires to teach Christians what it is to die with Christ, to ourselves, and to the world. As we have been raised by baptism with Christ into a new life of love, joy and peace in Him. When we learn this basic lesson of “cross bearing”, our lives will come alive to Him who is the eternal Life Himself!
