A Glimpse of God

He who calls you is faithful, who also will do it.

1 Thessalonians 5:24

Coupled with the greatest wish that one can make for other Christians is a statement about God. It is only a short sentence, but it reminds us of one of the magnificent attributes of God.

We know that “people become like the God that they worship.” This fact gives us a reason for studying Him through this word of praise: “Faithful is He who calls you, and He will bring it to pass” (1 Thess. 5:24). This truth can move us a little closer to God’s likeness. What do we see in this sentence?

Looking At God’s character. Of all the traits that God possesses, one of the most encouraging to sinners like us is the realization that God can be trusted. Just as God is love, He is also fidelity. No matter what happens, God will never waver in who He is. We may not know why certain things happen to us or around us, but we can put our faith in the proposition that God will always keep His promises.

Thinking of God’s actions. Occasionally it is said of a person, “We just never know how he is going to act,” or “We have to be careful around him, for we just can’t predict how he will react!” Never fear, God will always act in harmony with His

character. No one will ever find God being erratic or two-faced.

Remembering God's constancy. What God was yesterday, He will be today and tomorrow. James said that in God there is "no variation or shifting shadow" ([James 1:17](#)). In other words, God never changes.

Of course, we cannot begin to know everything about God. He is so vast, so transcendent, so mighty; yet we can know some truths about Him. We can base our eternal hope on His integrity. Thinking about this keeps us faithful to Him and keeps us growing in our love for Him. It puts our hearts at rest that in a changing, uncertain world, we find God faithful to those who trust in Him.
