Lessons From Geese

This was passed on to me from a member. I have seen some of these points made before in other places. Perhaps it will be an encouragement to you.

As each goose flaps its wings, it creates an “uplift” for the geese following. By flying in a “V” formation, the whole flock adds 71% more flying range than if each goose flew alone. Lesson: People who share a common direction and sense of community can get where they are going more quickly and easily because they are traveling on the thrust of one another.

Whenever a goose falls out of formation, it suddenly feels the draft and resistance of trying to fly alone and quickly gets back into formation to take advantage of the “lifting power” of the birds immediately in front. Lesson: If we have as much sense as a goose, we will unite with those who are headed where we want to go.

Whenever the lead goose gets tired, it rotates back into the formation and another goose flies at the point position. Lesson: It pays to take turns doing the hard tasks and sharing leadership. People, like geese, need to be interdependent.

The geese in formation “honk” from behind to encourage those up front to keep up their speed. Lesson: We need to

make sure our “honking” from behind is encouraging – not something less helpful.

When a goose gets sick or is wounded or shot down, two geese drop out of formation and follow their fellow members down to help and provide protection. They stay with this member of the flock until he or she is either able to fly again or dies. Then they launch out on their own with another formation or catch up with their own flock. Lesson: If we had the sense God gave a goose, we would stand by each other like that.
