As Sons of Light

But you, brethren, are not in darkness, so that this Day should overtake you as a thief. You are all sons of light and sons of the day. We are not of the night nor of darkness. Therefore, let us not sleep, as others do, but let us watch and be sober. For those who sleep, sleep at night, and those who get drunk are drunk at night. But let us who are of the day be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love, and as a helmet the hope of salvation. For God did not appoint us to wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, who died for us, that whether we wake or sleep, we should live together with Him. Therefore comfort each other and edify one another, just as you also are doing.

1 Thessalonians 5:4-11

Inasmuch as Jesus will come as a thief in the night, how then should we live? Two traits of Christian character are appropriately brought out by Paul.

We are to be watchful. We do not live in the darkness, unaware that Jesus might come. We know the truth about His coming, so we walk in the knowledge of this truth. Paul said that we are “sons of light” because we live in the truth and are

characterized by light. He said that we are “sons of the day” because we live our lives in view of the day of the Lord. We know that day is coming, and we live in a state of readiness for it.

We are to be sober. We are not asleep, but we are awake and alert to what could happen at any time. Some, he said, are like drunken men in the night. They are not serious about life and are not conscious of the possibilities. The Christian enjoys life, but he has a sober side to him. He knows that at any moment he could see the end of all things.

Every Christian in every age should live as if Jesus could come at any time. We are to be watchful and sober.
