The moment [Jesus] came out of the water, he saw the sky split open and God's Spirit, looking like a dove, come down on him.

Mark 1:10 MESSAGE

Winning the Super Bowl, winning the World Cup, winning Wimbledon, winning the British Open, winning the Daytona 500, and winning the World Series are considered lifetime achievements for those involved in the respective sports. Yet none of these victories even approaches the significance of the moment in today's verse. Jesus, with droplets of water from the Jordan River running down his face, is honored in a powerful way by God. More than just the words of affirmation that Jesus receives ([Mark 1:11](#)), heaven is torn open – surely a sign of a world-changing event. The Holy Spirit of God comes in a visible form to show heaven's approval. Jesus is recognized as awesome: not awesome in the sense of some great athletic achievement, but as one who is worthy of awe and reverence. God the Father and God the Spirit show the majesty of God the Son. The new age of God's grace is signaled by the heavens opening, and the power and peace of this grace are seen in **the coming of the Spirit.**

“Look! All these years I’ve been slaving for you and never disobeyed your orders. Yet you never gave me even a young goat so I could celebrate with my friends. But when this son of yours who has squandered your property with prostitutes comes home, you kill the fattened calf for him!”

Luke 15:20, 30

Telling the parable of the prodigal son is usually focused on the love and forgiveness of the father. It teaches us of the forgiveness of our Father once we repent, no matter how great our sin. We rarely focus on the selfishness of the older brother. The brother did not even acknowledge his younger brother, calling him “this son of yours.”

Sometimes we feel like this brother. It doesn’t seem fair. We could easily be in the same situation. This brother undoubtedly had not heard the parable of the vineyard workers. Most likely he could have been like the workers who had worked all day. It was unfair that their pay was the same as those who had worked for a few hours. They expected more, although they got exactly what they had agreed upon. **Matthew 20:1-16**

Haven’t you felt exactly as the brother and the workers did, at one time or another? But that is not God’s way, is it? Suppose someone is righteous all of their life, while someone else is wicked, but in their later years, they repent. Is this fair? Don’t be like the older brother. Jesus tells us, *“...there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent.”*
