Jesus’ Life in Four Words

What did Jesus do for you and me as an incredible demonstration of His genuine love for us? Whatever He did we do not deserve; it was an act of God’s amazing grace and we can never repay the debt we owe Him.

1. HE CAME. He came from heaven to earth. He Himself said, *For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent me (John 6:38)*. Paul summed it up when he said *Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners (1 Timothy 1:15)*. If Jesus had not come, we could never be saved from our sins.

2. HE WENT. He went to the cross. When the mob came to take Him in the Garden of Gethsemane, He could have called 12 legions (72,000) of powerful angels to protect Him (**Matthew 26:53**), but He didn’t. Jesus had the power to escape the Jewish court, including the interrogations of Pilate and Herod, but He chose not to. Instead, He endured mockery, physical and mental torture. With the help of Simon, He carried His cross *to the place called Calvary . . . here they crucified Him (Luke 23:33)*.

Why did our loving Lord go to the cross when He could have avoided it? The Bible’s answer is plain: *Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree (1 Peter 2:24)*. If Jesus had not gone to the cross, we would be hopelessly lost!

3. HE STAYED. He stayed on the cross where He suffered for six long hours. While hanging there, some mockingly spoke words of blasphemy: *Save Yourself and come down from the cross . . . He saved others; Himself he cannot save* (**Mark 15:30-31**).

Though Jesus had the power to come down from the cross, He refused to do so! He remained nailed to that cross until the bitter end, because He loves us with a perfect love and wanted to save us from being eternally lost.

4. HE RETURNED. After His resurrection He returned to heaven, where He sat down at the right hand of the Father (**Mark 16:19**). He went *into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us* (**Hebrew 9:24**). Upon His return to heaven, He was given *dominion, and glory, and a kingdom* (**Daniel 7:13-14**). *He ever lives to make intercession for us* (**Hebrew 7:25**).

May the simple story of Jesus' perfect love never cease to thrill us!
