“The Lord Is My Shepherd”

Psalms 23:3

The average American today understands little about what a professional shepherd is and does. Greater understanding into the real meaning of this psalm came from reading a book written by a modern shepherd.

The most important thing we learn from the opening words of this psalm is how personal our relationship is with our spiritual shepherd. Christians today know Jesus as our Good Shepherd. The words **I AM** that Jesus used so often during His earthly ministry reflect the name of Jehovah God Himself (**Ex. 3:14**). Jesus said **I AM the Good Shepherd and I know my sheep and am known by My own.** (**John 10:14**).

Only those who obey Jesus as Lord can know Him as their Good Shepherd and only His obedient sheep are known by Him. There is no greater blessing in this world of sin than to know Jesus as our Good Shepherd and to know that He knows us as His sheep. Because Jesus is Almighty God Himself, there is no need (physical, mental, or spiritual) that we may have, that He is incapable of providing! Therefore, each of His sheep can thankfully

say: **I shall not want!** Matthew recorded of Jesus: **But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd (Matt. 9:36).** The greatest burden Jesus has is for sheep who have no shepherd. Jesus' burden for such weary and scattered sheep was so heavy that it brought Him from the highest heaven to the lowliest on earth – death on a cross.

Jesus made it clear in the next two verses of **Matthew 9**, that those who follow Him as their Good Shepherd share His burden for the lost: Then He said to His disciples, The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore, pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest (**Matt. 9:37-38**). Jesus' words reflect the great "marching orders" of His Great Commission (**Matt. 28:28-20**). May each Christian take these words seriously enough to do whatever we can to bring lost and wandering sheep to Jesus that they may also know Him as their Good Shepherd.
