BELIEVING IN GOD

*As it is written: “I have made you a father of many nations.”
He is our father in the sight of God, in whom he believed –
God who gives life to the dead and calls into being things that
were not. – Romans 4:17*

Abraham’s faith was not in himself, but in God. Abraham’s faith was not even in his faith, but in his Lord. Some of us are so works-oriented that, if we are not careful, we can begin to think that it is the strength of our faith that is most important. Faith can be “weak” ([Rom. 4:19](#)) or “strong” ([Rom. 4:20](#)), and our faith needs to grow ([see Rom. 4:20](#)). Nevertheless, regarding justification, the quantity or quality of our faith is not as important as the focus of our faith.

Imagine that you come to a deep, wide chasm that you must cross. Visualize three approaches to reaching the other side. You might try jumping across; this could illustrate faith in self. (Oops, there you go, plunging into the depths of the chasm!) A second approach might be to utilize a rope, firmly tied above – a rope long enough to swing across the chasm. You hold the end of the rope and swing across. This method involves a double faith focus: You have faith that the rope will hold you up, but you also have faith in yourself – that you can hold on until you are safely on the other side. The third approach involves a bridge across the chasm. You walk across the bridge

because you believe that the bridge will hold you up as you cross. It is not your faith that supports you, but the bridge. Perhaps you cross confidently, or perhaps you cross nervously. Either way, it is not the quality or the quantity of your faith that holds you up, but the bridge.

The focus of Abraham's faith was not himself. It was not even his faith. (Abraham's faith was far from perfect.) Rather, Abraham had faith in God. Likewise, the focus of our faith should be God. Even when we are spiritually dead, He can give us life (Eph. 2:5). Someday He will give new life to our dead bodies. Further, He is able to look at us and see the potential in our lives, even when we are sinners, and call "into being that which does not exist" (Rom. 4:17). Faith can also be "little" (Matt. 14:31; 16:8) or "great" (Matt. 8:10, 26), "dead" (James 2:17, 26) or alive.
