Walking in Newness of Life

Romans 6:3-4: *Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father even so we also should walk in newness of life.*

In this passage Paul describes baptism as a “reenactment” of faith in the death, burial and resurrection of our Lord. We die to the old life of sin, bury the old man of sin into Christ’s death and are raised to **walk in newness of life**. One great way to describe the Christian life is as a “walk”. Only the redeemed can enjoy the activity of walking in newness of life. Just as Jesus healed the lame man and told him to **Arise and walk (Matt. 9:5)**, Jesus has come into our lives through the Holy Spirit to spiritually empower us to walk in our new life in Him. Our walk is one of faith and, like Enoch and Noah, we choose to walk with God (cf. **Gen. 5:25; 6:9**). David could have been describing Christians when he wrote, **Blessed are the people who know the joyful sound! They walk, O Lord, in the light of Your countenance (Psa. 89:15)**. Isaiah promised that **those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength: they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint (Isa. 40:31)**.

Jesus, the Almighty Risen One, has raised us from the spiritually dead, so that by His power we might walk with Him in the new life of faith. To assist us He has put His Holy Spirit within us (**Ezek. 36:27; 1 Jn. 1:7**). The old song says it well: "When we walk with the Lord in the light of His Word, what a glory He sheds on our way! While we do His good will, He abides with us still, and with all who will trust and obey. Trust and obey, for there's no other way to be happy in Jesus, but to trust and obey". All Christians should take the time each morning to bow before the Lord to ask Him for His spiritual power to walk in the light of His gospel throughout the day!
