"At the Center of God's Love"

But you, dear friends, carefully build yourselves up in this most holy faith by praying in the Holy Spirit, staying right at the center of God's love, keeping your arms open and outstretched, ready for the mercy of our Master, Jesus Christ. This is the unending life, the *real* life! — [Jude 20-21 MESSAGE](#)

Prayer is a gift from God empowered by the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit intercedes for us, and this intercession goes beyond our words ([Romans 8:26-27](#)). Jesus, through the Holy Spirit, gives us access to God ([Ephesians 2:18](#)). The Spirit of God within us joins with our spirit and testifies that we are God's children so we can approach him as our "Abba Father" ([Romans 8:14-17](#)). Thus, we can come to the Creator and Sustainer of the universe at any time and know we are valued and heard. So if we want to stay in the "center of God's love," we must take advantage of this grace of prayer — intentionally coming into the presence of God, entreating the Holy Spirit to intercede for us and carry us along in our moments of prayer as we speak to God, spirit to Spirit ([Romans 8:27](#); [1 Corinthians 2:10-16](#)). Praying in the Spirit is to center ourselves in the grace and love of God. We, as his dearly loved children, come to him in dependent trust and confident hope, knowing that we are heard because of the gift of his Spirit within us. phil@heartlight.org

Be Separate

2 Corinthians 6:17 – “Therefore, come out from among them and be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, and I will receive you.” As a seaport and a hub of art and industry in the Roman world, Corinth was a prosperous metropolitan center. It was also a center for immorality and materialism. In this environment the Corinth church was begun and they struggled with how to relate to their ungodly culture. Paul’s admonition in verse 17, was to come out from among them and be separate. Paul warned the church in Corinth to not imitate the immoral practices of their surrounding pagan neighbors.

Paul’s charge to be separate has been interpreted in many ways through the centuries. Some believers segregate themselves from the world and refuse to participate as members of society outside of their immediate circle of Christian friends. Some groups go so far as to shun modern conveniences as basic as electricity, and live as groups which are fully secluded from the culture around them. Other groups refuse to build any relationship with nonbelievers for fear of becoming entangled in their worldly ways. Rather than requiring believers to live in isolation from the world, Paul called Christians to be set apart in their lifestyles. Instead of participating in the immoral activities of the people around them, Christians are to come out of pagan lifestyles and pursue holiness. In so doing, their lives draw attention to Jesus. Paul’s admonition echoes Jesus’ call to be salt and light in this dark and sinful world (**Matt. 5:13-16**). Since salt has no value if it loses its saltiness, a believer who reflects the sinful behavior of the world loses his ability to reach others. Like a light on a lampstand, believers should strive to shine in the darkness. This can only occur when believers choose a life of holiness and purity, in contrast to the sinful behavior of the surrounding culture.
