Answer Me When I Call

Psalms 4:1 "Answer me when I call, O God of my righteousness! You have relieved me in my distress: be gracious to me and hear my prayer" (NASB)

As we make our journey through this life with all of its trouble and strife, we desperately need the love, mercy and compassion of our God to surround us each step of the way. We are weak, frail human beings and as one of our grand old songs proclaims it so well: "I need thee every hour, most gracious Lord; no tender voice like thine can peace afford. I need thee; Every hour I need thee".

If there is one thing I know about life, it is that life is full of ups and downs. Without God there is no hope but with him there is an anchor for our souls that will enable us to overcome anything that threatens us in this life, God will take care of us if we are faithful and true to him (**Romans 8:31; Hebrews 6:19; Isaiah 40:31; Psalms 46:1; Psalms 55:22; 1 Peter 5:7; Philippians 4:19**).

We must be careful not to let the problems of this life overshadow the many wonderful blessings our God has bestowed upon us. Hardly a day passes in my life without some problem occurring. But when night falls and I pillow my head in sleep there is a smile on my face because in my heart I know that God has abundantly blessed me. One of those great blessings is knowing that he is gracious to me and hears my prayer when I call out to him (**Hebrews 4:16; Philippians 4:6-7**). As I think about the gift of his Son, as I think about the church and the privilege I have of being part of his kingdom, then all the problems I face seem as nothing, What is true for me, I believe is or at least can be true for you also.
