The Will – Not the Emotions

Man's nature consists of "spirit, soul and body" (1 Thess. 5:23). The Christian's body is "the temple of the Holy Spirit" (1 Cor. 6:19). The Old Testament temple consisted of three parts: the Outer Court, the Holy Place and the Most Holy Place. As a New Testament temple, the Christian's physical body is the Outer Court. The Holy Place is our soul which consists of our intellect, will and emotions. Our Most Holy Place is where God is to reside as a Holy Guest as He makes Himself at home in our hearts.

Our soul meditates upon God's Holy Word of truth; our will chooses to live by faith; our emotions follow our faith and must never become the governing authority of our lives. A major mistake many Christians make today is to try to run the train of their lives by the locomotive of emotion, rather than the truth of God's Word. Emotions make a great caboose as they follow the locomotive of God's Word and our obedience of faith. Fickle feelings must never be trusted as the authority in our relationship of faith with God!

How unfortunate it is that even modern churches attempt to appeal to the emotions of their worshippers. The question is not what pleases God in their worship, but what makes the worshippers feel good. Such an approach makes the emotions king of our worship. The only "King" must be Jesus who rules our wills by the authority of His word of truth.

The secret of the Christian life is to submit my will to Christ the King so that He might rule my life in all authority. By "will", I do not mean my wishes or longings, but my decisions and choices. Each day we choose to live for the flesh or for the Spirit. The former is a choice of sight; the latter is a choice of faith. When the will of Christ becomes my only will, I live by faith.

A Closing Reflection: A Christian is a mind through which Christ thinks, a heart through which Christ loves and a hand through which Christ helps.
